Check-List of Guam Fishes, Supplement I

This list of Guam fishes, consisting of 45 families and 133 species, is a supplement to the Check-list of Guam fishes, Kami, *et al.* (1968). With the addition of the families Alopidae, Anomalopidae, Champsodontidae, Echeneidae, Grammistidae, Hexanchidae, Monodactylidae, Myliobatidae, Paralepidae, and Sphyrnidae, the supplement increases the number of families represented in Guam to 90. The number of species is increased to 598.

Many of the deep water species, especially the groupers (Serranidae) and snappers (Lutjanidae) were taken on handline by the crew of the M/V PANGLAU ORO, the research vessel of the Division of Fish and Wildlife, operating under Commercial Fisheries Research and Development Act of 1964 (P. L. 88–309). Also, through the courtesy of Dr. R. S. Jones, the fish collection at the University of Guam was made available. Specimens from the University collection included in this list are denoted by an asterisk.

Some of the species cited in the check-list (loc. cit.) were from published records only. Many of these have subsequently been collected and are listed in the appendix.

Families are arranged alphabetically. The vernacular name of some species is enclosed in brackets.

In the previous check-list, the family Zanclidae is represented by two species, Zanclus cornutus (Linnaeus) and Z. canescens (Linnaeus). The former is recognized as the adult of the latter, as pointed out by Randall (1955c).

Subsequent to the publication of the check-list of Gaum fishes, the Division's fish collection was deposited at the University of Guam to form the nucleus of the University's fish collection.

I would like to thank Dr. V. G. Springer for identifying many of the blennies, and to Drs. R. S. Jones and J. E. Randall for their comments and review of the manuscript. Dr. Randall also identified several of the species from Guam presently at the Bishop Museum. Most of the specimens from the University's collection were identified by Helen K. Larson.
